



## **FISHING RULES FOR LAKE BLEĐ**

- Fishing is allowed from all banks of Lake Bled from dawn until dusk, and until 23:00 hours during July and August.
- Fishing from a boat is allowed from May 15th. 2 rods can be used when trolling. If boat is anchored, only 1 rod can be used. Trolling with an electric motor is allowed.
- Fly fishing on Lake Bled is allowed.
- Fishing from the bank is allowed with single end tackle using 1 natural or artificial bait.
- Trout fishing is allowed only with artificial lures. During conservation period for trout, (October 1st to March 31st), minimum length of artificial lures must be 10 cm.
- Carp up to 7 kg (15lb 7oz) can be taken within the daily bag. Heavier carp must be returned unharmed immediately.
- All fish must be treated decently and with respect.
- All fish caught for consumption as part of the daily bag must be killed immediately.
- Fish are measured from the front of the head to the back end of the tail fin.
- Fish caught for consumption must be kept until the end of fishing.
- In case of bad weather, the use of larger umbrellas on the banks is allowed.
  
- In protected areas, during protected periods (marked on the map), fishing is not allowed. Fishing on effluents is not allowed!
- Trolling with a motor boat is not allowed.
- Using live fish, frogs, clams and maggots as bait is not allowed! When fishing with natural dead bait (fish, entrails, worms), the use of single hook is obligatory.
- Taking live fish away is prohibited.
- Keeping live fish in nets is not allowed.
- When the maximum daily bag is caught, fishing must stop!
- On the banks of Lake Bled, the use of tents and bivvies with a ground sheet is not allowed! Stoves for cooking food and drinks is not allowed!

## **PROTECTED AREAS**

### **Area 1 (till June 15th)**

From the bridge on the promenade path of Villa Bled, (approximately 40 metres inside the protective wall) up to the sign on the Bled-Zaka road which indicates end of protected area.

### **Area 2 (September 1st to December 31st)**

From and including piers at the rowing centre to the boat moorings at Bled Fishing Club HQ.
